Background

Across the world, millions of families have been torn apart by the death of loved ones. All too often, orphans and widows are left to fend for them, grieving, struggling and in desperate need of support.

Women, many newly married or elderly lose their husbands to crime, disease and extreme poverty. They are left with the duty of providing for their family. Many widows live in cultures where women are not educated and men are the sole breadwinners of the family, so when a woman becomes a widow, she has no skills to make a living from. To make matters worse, in many cultures widows are denied their rights. They lose their home and property due to a lack of inheritance entitlements. They are exposed to sexual violence, isolated from the community and labelled as an 'untouchable'. Children of widows are mistreated by association.


As a result, many children and youths fall deeper into poverty with no prospects of having a better life. Some live in houses made of scrap material, like mud and sheets of steel. Families of 8 or 9 are crammed into one small room which serves as their home, their kitchen and bathroom with makeshift beds all in one area, increasing the risk of disease and ultimately, death. It is for reasons such as these that Dukedom Foundation Inc. has decided to help alleviate some of these situations.

• Promote the economic, social, educational and domestic interest of underserved persons, focusing on the rural areas.

• Create a focal point for common discussion to establish awareness concerning problems faced by children and the youth, felt needs, and availability of local and external resources, which could be tapped to address those problems

• Assist in schooling of needy orphan children in the first and second cycle institutions in particular and where necessary, in tertiary institutions

• Provide job opportunities, vocational training and medical support to the youth as a way to improve their economic conditions.


